- 1 Every 3 hours** in the United States, a person or vehicle is hit by a train.
- 2 Trains can't stop quickly.** It can take up to a mile or more for a train to come to a full and complete stop. That's the length of 18 football fields.
- 3 Trains cannot swerve.** They can only run on tracks. Trains can run on any track at any time in either direction.
- 4 Trains overhang tracks.** If you're too close, you could be hit even if you're not on the track.
- 5 More than 60% of incidents** occur at crossings with lights or gates.
