

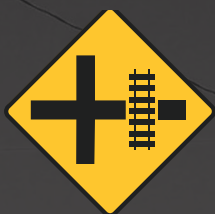
READ THE ROAD!

Every crossing, every time. Know before you go.

SIGNS AS YOU APPROACH:



Advance Warning sign:
Approaching a railroad crossing.



Road Parallels Track sign:
There is a crossing after a turn (right or left). Not at every crossing.



Low Ground Clearance Sign:
Marks a crossing where low-ground clearance vehicles may get hung up. Not at every crossing.

Storage Space Signs: These signs indicate how many feet are present between train tracks and highway. When they are present, it is important to note the number to calculate when a truck can fully clear a crossing.

Multiple Tracks Sign: More than one set of tracks at this crossing. The number on the sign tells you how many tracks are present at the crossing.

Emergency Notification System Sign:
Blue and white sign to directly reach the railroad if you are stuck, stalled or see an emergency on the tracks.

Flashing Lights and Gates: Train is approaching. Trains always have the right-of-way. Never drive around the gates.

Crossbuck Sign: Yield to a train if approaching. Trains always have the right-of-way!

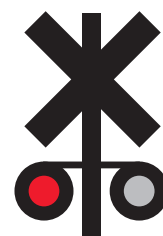
