Always expect a train. Trains can start moving at any time.



There is only room for trains on the tracks.
Trains overhang the tracks.



Cross only at designated crossings.
Walk things like bikes and scooters
over the tracks when it is safe
to cross.



Always look both ways.

multiple trains.
